1 Kings 19:19 (NLT), “So Elijah went and found Elisha son of Shaphat plowing a field. There were **twelve teams** of oxen in the field, and Elisha was plowing with the twelfth team. Elijah went over to him and **threw his cloak** across his shoulders and **then walked away.**”

Matthew 6:4 (NIV), “Your Father, who sees what is done in **secret**, will **reward** you.”

James 4:10 (NLT), “**Humble** yourselves before the Lord, and He will **lift you up** in honor.”

2 Kings 2:9-10 (NIV), “When they had crossed, Elijah said to Elisha, ‘Tell me, what can I do for you before I am taken from you?’ **‘Let me inherit a double portion of your spirit,’** Elisha replied. ‘You have asked a difficult thing,’ Elijah said, ‘yet if you see me when I am taken from you, it will be yours – otherwise, it will not.’”

Mark 11:23-24 (NLT), “I tell you the truth, you can say to this mountain, ‘May you be lifted up and thrown into the sea,’ and it will happen. But you must **really believe** it will happen and have **no doubt** in your heart. ²⁴ I tell you, **you can pray for anything**, and if you believe **that you have received it**, it will be yours.”

2 Kings 3:15 (NIV), “But now **bring me a harpist.**” While the harpist was playing, the hand of the LORD came upon Elisha.”

2 Kings 3:16-18 (NIV), “And he said, ‘This is what the LORD says: Make this **valley** full of ditches. For this is what the LORD says: **You will see neither wind nor rain**, yet this valley will be filled with water, and you, your cattle and your other animals will drink. This is an **easy thing** in the eyes of the LORD; he will also hand Moab over to you.’”

1 Chronicles 4:9-10 (NLT), “There was a man named Jabez who was **more honorable** than any of his brothers. His mother named him **Jabez** because his birth had been so **painful**. ¹⁰ He was the one who **prayed** to the God of Israel, ‘Oh, that you would **bless** me and **expand** my territory! Please be with me in **all that I do**, and keep me from all **trouble** and **pain!**’ And God **granted** him his request.”
