1. Be \_\_\_\_\_ to prayer.

Romans 12:12, “Be devoted to prayer.”

1 Thessalonians 5:17, (NASB) “Pray without ceasing.”

Colossians 4:2 (NLT), “<sup>2</sup>Devote yourselves to prayer with an alert mind and a thankful heart.”

Acts 2:42, “They were continually **devoting** themselves to the apostles’ teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to **prayer**.”

2. Believe in the \_\_\_\_\_ of prayer.

James 5:16b (NIV), “The prayer of a righteous person is **powerful and effective**.”

Ephesians 3:20 (NIV), “Now to him who is able to do **immeasurably more** than all we ask or imagine, according to **his power** that is at work within us.”

Proverbs 18:21a, “Death and life are in the **power of the tongue**.”

3. Eliminate the \_\_\_\_\_ to prayer.

- Eliminate \_\_\_\_\_:

Matthew 14:23 (NASB), “After He had sent the **crowds away**, He went up on the mountain **by Himself** to pray; and when it was evening, He was there **alone**.”

- Find a private \_\_\_\_\_:

Matthew 6:6 (NASB), “**But as for you, when you pray**, go into your inner room, close your door, **and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees what is done in secret will reward you.**”

- Examine your \_\_\_\_\_:

James 4:2b-3 (NASB), “You do not have because **you do not ask**. You ask \_\_\_\_\_ and do not receive, because you ask with **wrong motives**, so that you may spend it on your pleasures.”

- Confess and \_\_\_\_\_:

Psalms 66:18-19 (NLT), “<sup>18</sup>If I had not **confessed the sin** in my heart, the Lord **would not** have listened. <sup>19</sup>But God did listen! He **paid attention to my prayer**.”

Mark 11:25-26 (NASB), “<sup>25</sup>And whenever you stand praying, **forgive**, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father who is in heaven will **also forgive you** for your offenses. <sup>26</sup>But **if you do not forgive, neither** will your Father who is in heaven forgive **your offenses**.”

4. Pray with faithful \_\_\_\_\_.

1 John 5:14-15 (NIV), “<sup>14</sup>This is the **confidence** we have in approaching God: that if we **ask anything** according to **his will**, he **hears** us. <sup>15</sup>And if we know that he hears us – **whatever we ask** – we know that **we have what we asked of him**.”

Mark 11:24, (NASB) “Therefore I say to you, **all things for which you pray** and ask, **believe** that you **have received** them, and they shall be **granted** you.”

John 15:7 (NLT), “**But if you remain in me** and my words remain in you, **you may ask for anything** you want, and it will be **granted!**”

Matthew 18:19 (NASB), “Again I say to you, that if two of you **agree** on earth about **anything** that they may ask, **it shall be done** for them by My Father who is in heaven.”
