Jeremiah 17:9 (NLT), "The human heart is the most deceitful of all things, and desperately wicked. Who really knows how bad it is?" 1 John 1:9, (NIV), "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." Hebrews 4:12 (NIV), "For the word of God is alive and active. Luke 6:45 (NIV), "A good man brings good things out of the **good** stored up in his **heart**, and an evil man brings evil things out of the **evil** stored up in his **heart**. For the **mouth** speaks what the **heart is full** of."

3.	Transform your heart by	your mind.

Romans 12:2 (NIV), "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is – his good, pleasing and perfect will."

1 Chronicles 28:9 (NLT), "And Solomon, my son, learn to know the God of your ancestors intimately. Worship and serve him with your whole <a href="heart">heart</a> and a willing <a href="mind">mind</a>. For the Lord sees every heart and knows every plan and thought. If you seek him, you will find him. But if you forsake him, he will reject you forever."

**Philippians 4:8 (NLT),** "And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. **Fix your thoughts** on what is true, and honorable, and right, and **pure**, and lovely, and admirable. **Think about things** that are excellent and worthy of praise."
